

Photography and filming regulations for the Bear Cave in Kletno visitors.

1. Photography and filming during seeing the tourist route in the Bear Cave in Kletno is possible only after buying a special tickets according to price list of ZUT Bear Cave in Kletno.
2. After buying those special tickets – stickers, please stick them as the stuff and guide could see them.
3. Video filming is allowed only with digital cameras (without additional lights). Using tripods is not allowed.
4. Taking pictures is possible with traditional and digital cameras (it is possible to use inbuilt flash lamps). Using tripods is not allowed.
5. Filming and taking pictures is possible only if all regulations are being kept.
6. The person who is taking the pictures is not allowed to separate from the tourist group and like the others visitors should follow the tourist guide's instruction (filming and taking pictures cannot delay the pace of seeing the cave, the tour guide decide about the pace of the group).
7. Buying the ticket for filming and taking pictures is the proof of acquainting and accepting above-cited regulations.
8. Not obeying to those regulations by filming and taking pictures guests can cause loosing the right to film and take pictures in the Cave and can lead to calling the security service by the tour guide.
